AT A GLANCE:

The title of the talk series is G: Winning the Game of Money because it deals with three G's about money: Gift, Goal, and Grit—the titles of the three talks.

Gift is the talent or skill you receive as a blessing.

Goal is the purpose for the Gift.

Grit, according to the dictionary, is the passion and perseverance for the long-term and meaning goal: "It is the ability to persist in something you feel passionate about and persevere when you face obstacles. This kind of passion is not about intense emotions or infatuation."

AFTER THE SERIES:

G is also actually for Growing. Along the way, there will be many wonderful lessons you must learn in this journey, from financial literacy to financial psychology. But in the end, more than growing your cash, God wants you to grow your character. Believe that if you keep doing the right thing, money will follow at the right time.

Talk 3: Grit

WHAT IT'S ALL ABOUT:

Talk 3 is titled Grit because it is about perseverance. Grit, therefore, is the ability to complete something to the very end.

I. REVIEW THE KEY BIBLE VERSES:

The apostle James says, Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. (James 1:2-4 NIV).

II. ASK FOR REACTIONS AND REFLECTIONS

Ask members: What is your passion? What have you done so far to pursue your passion?

Ask What have been the obstacles blocking your effort to pursue your passion? What else can you do to develop your passion into something more profitable— so you will have more money for yourself, your family, and your ministry.

Ask members to make a Grit Calendar of mini-actions to reach their goal. Check on it in succeeding meetings.

III. PRAY FOR EACH OTHER

Pray that members will have the grit to pursue their passions.

Pray that members may be able to share this talk with those who need it most.
