healing, and miracles.

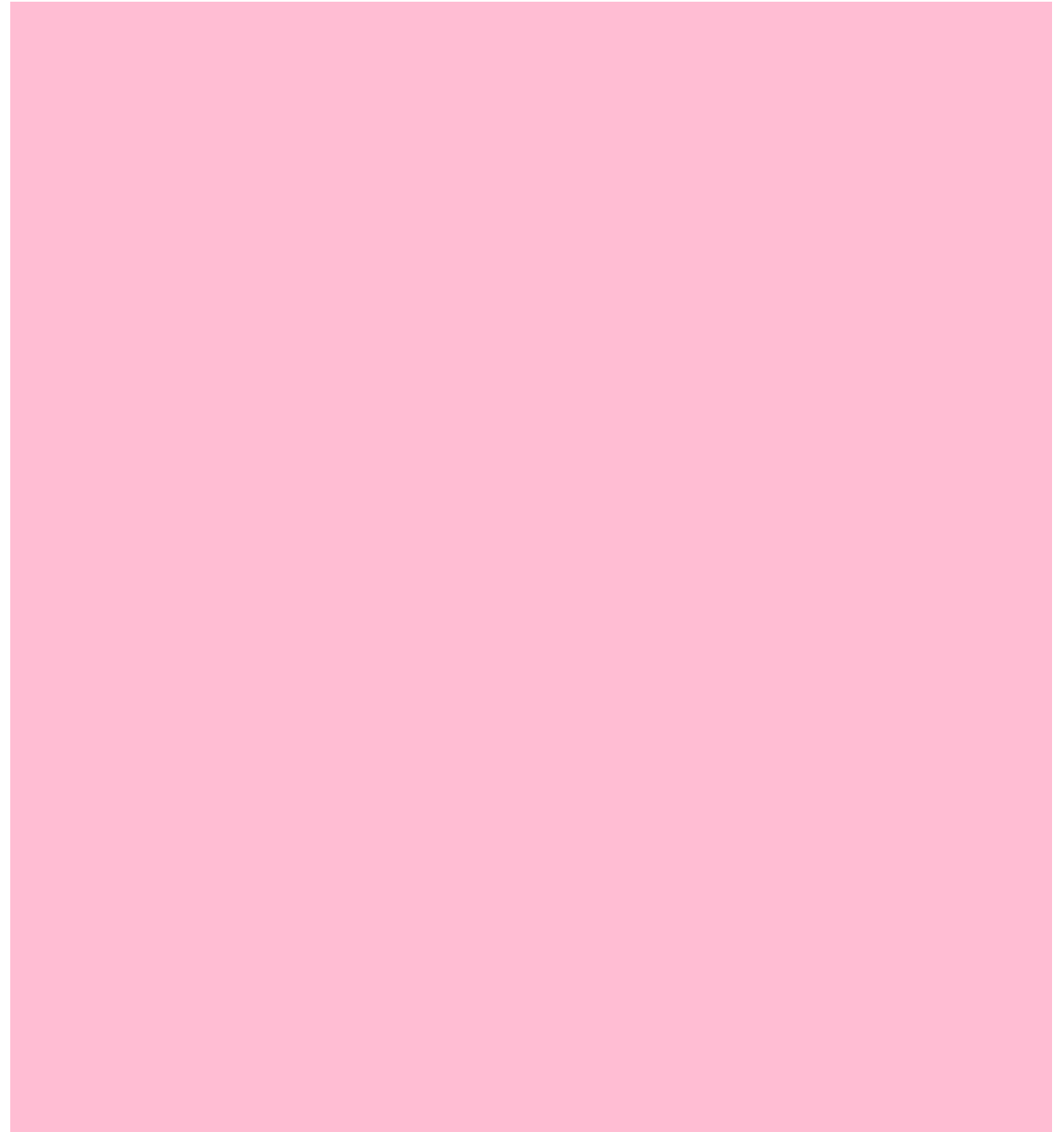


**Today, I open myself

like Jesus every day.**



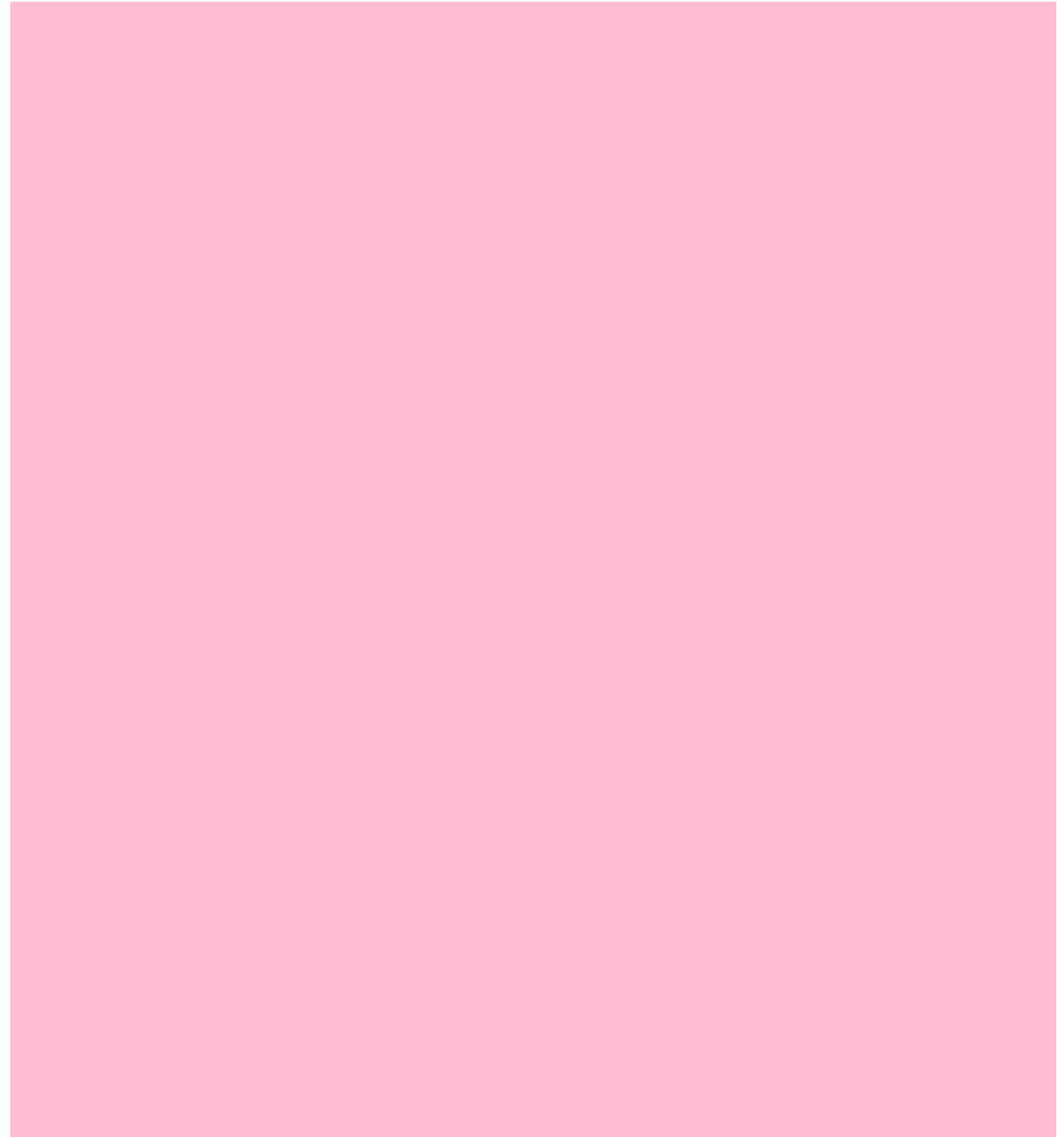

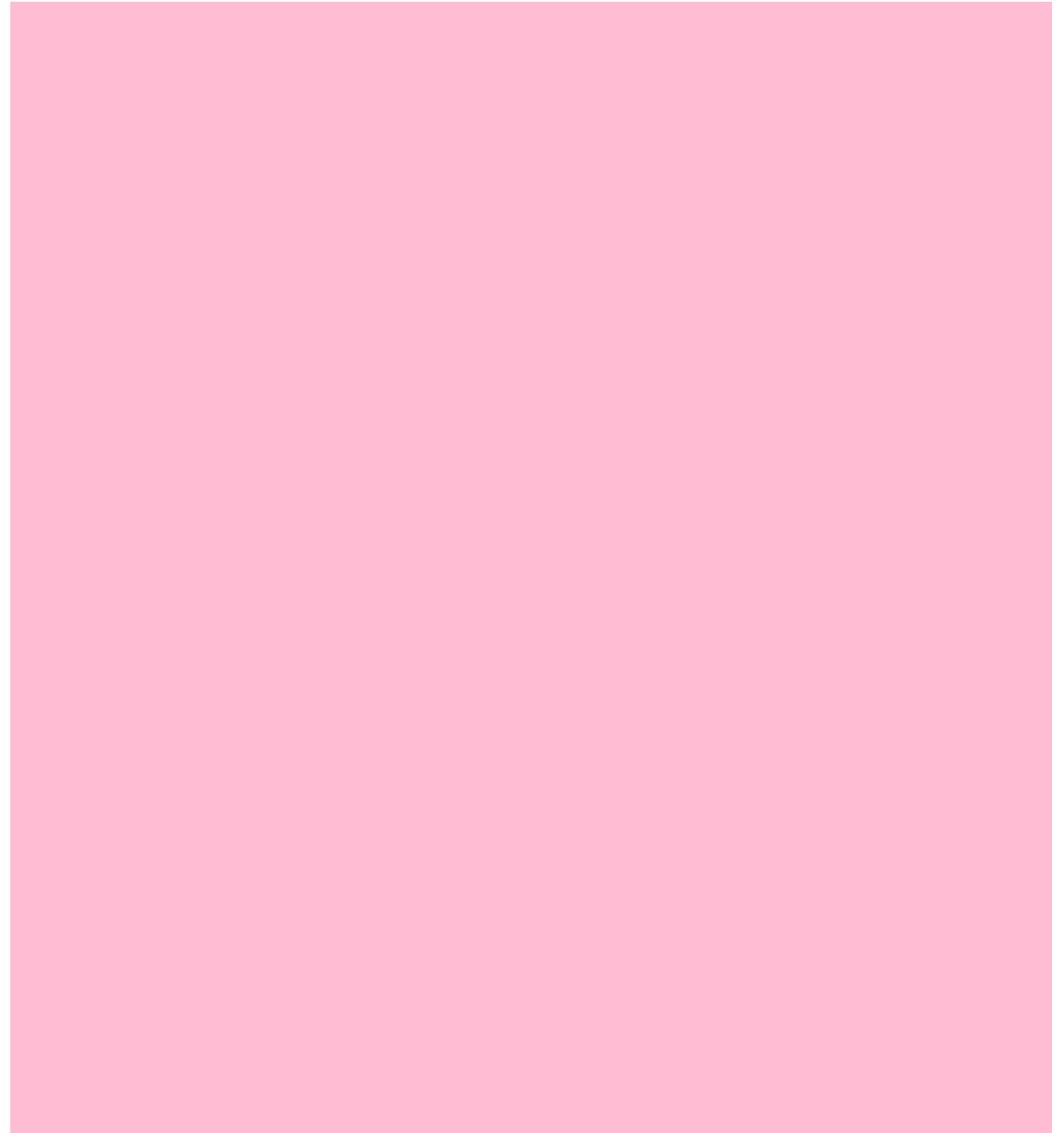

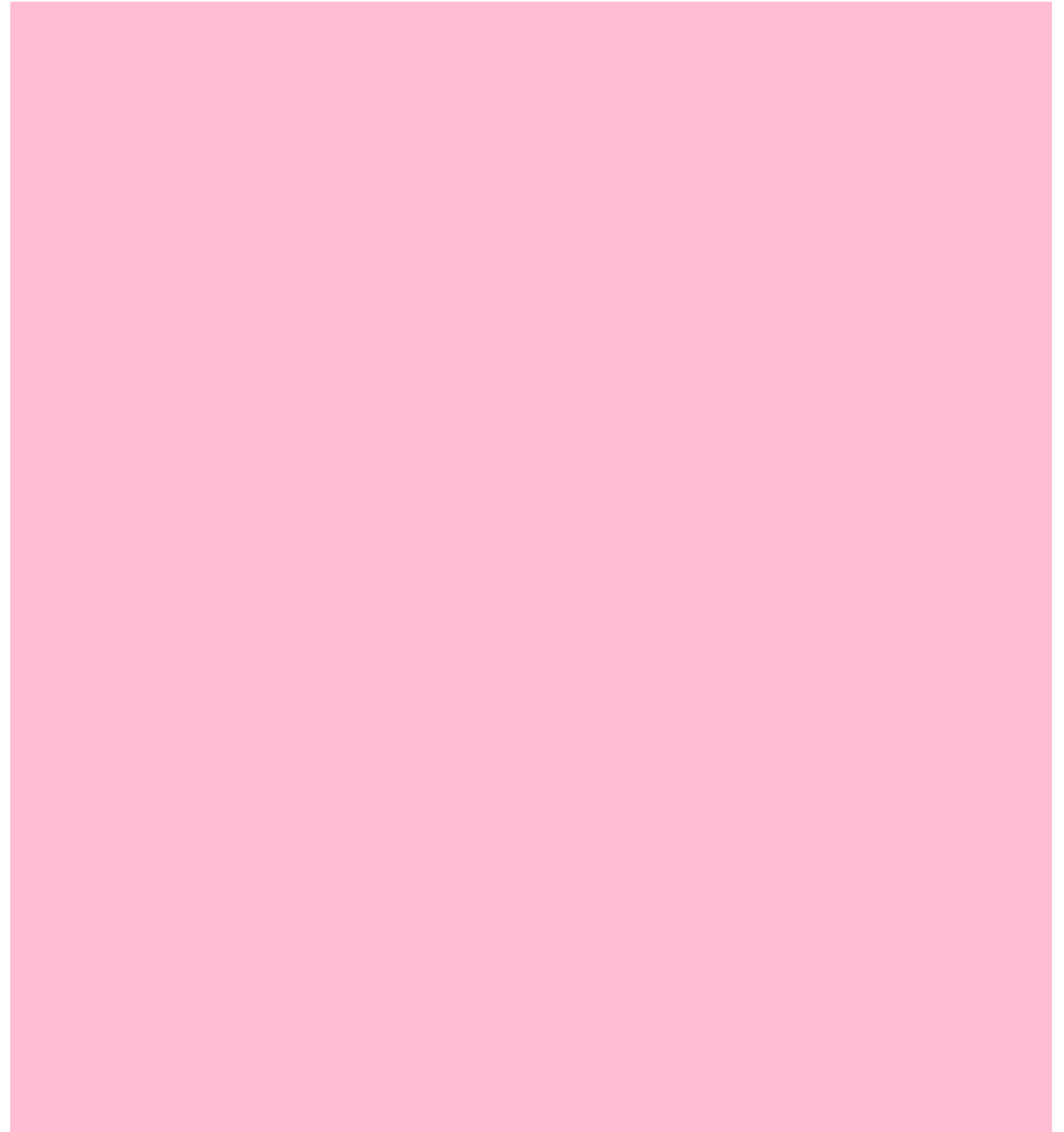

through our own *pride*.




4 Things You Can Do While Waiting

Wish

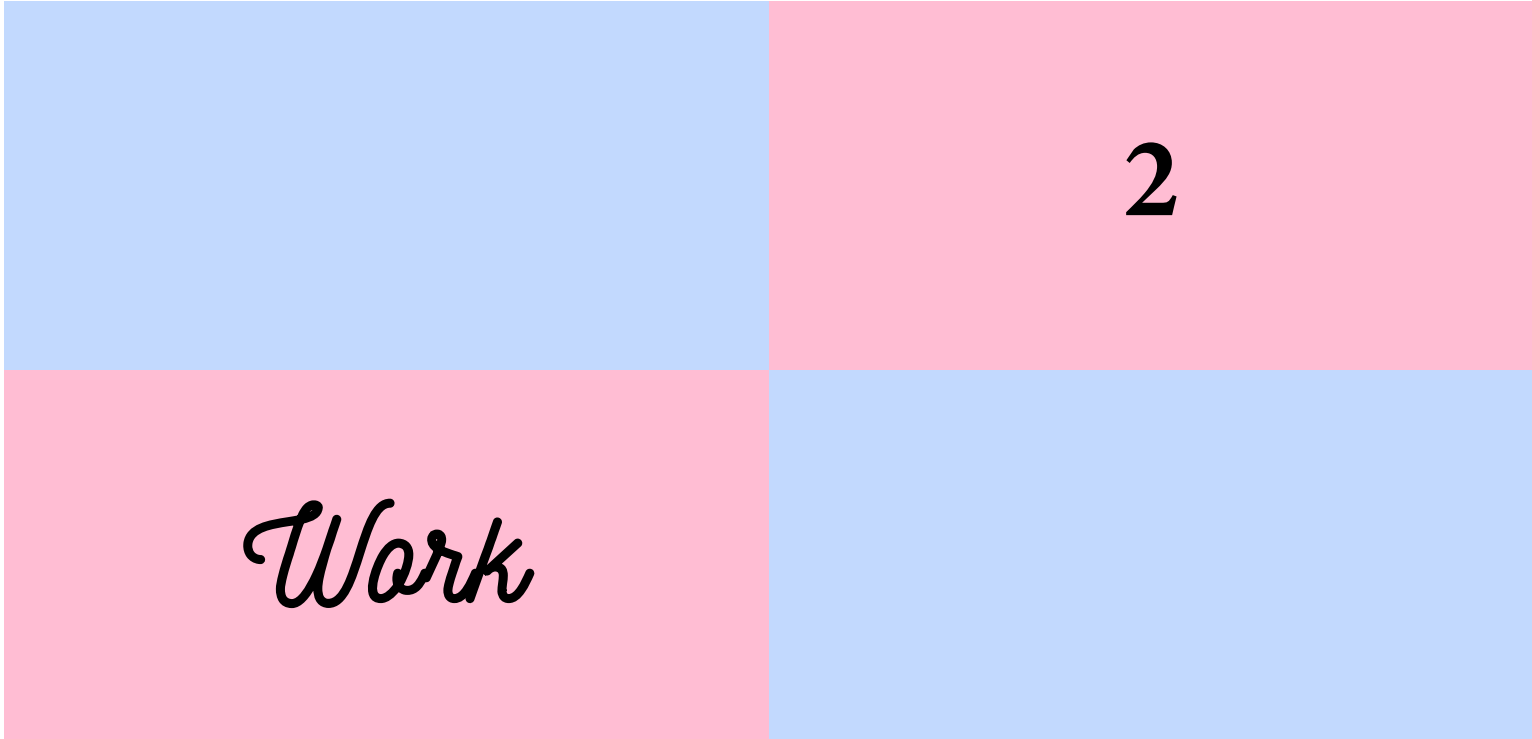
While you wait, **make a wish list.**
