**Immaturity is an I-problem.**



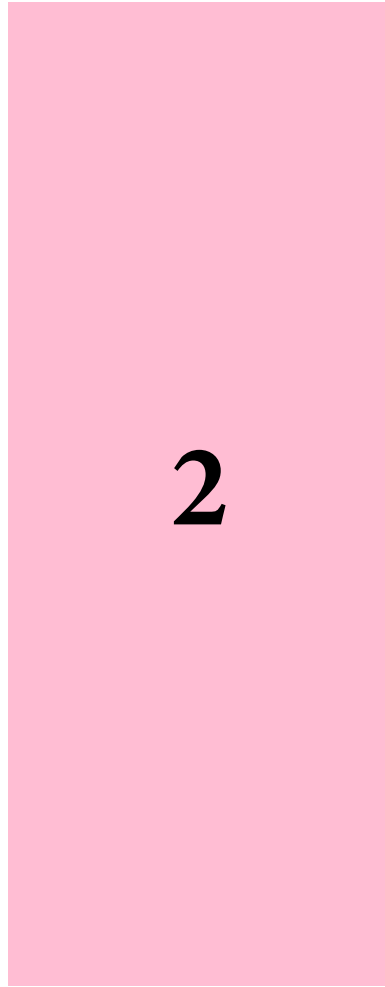
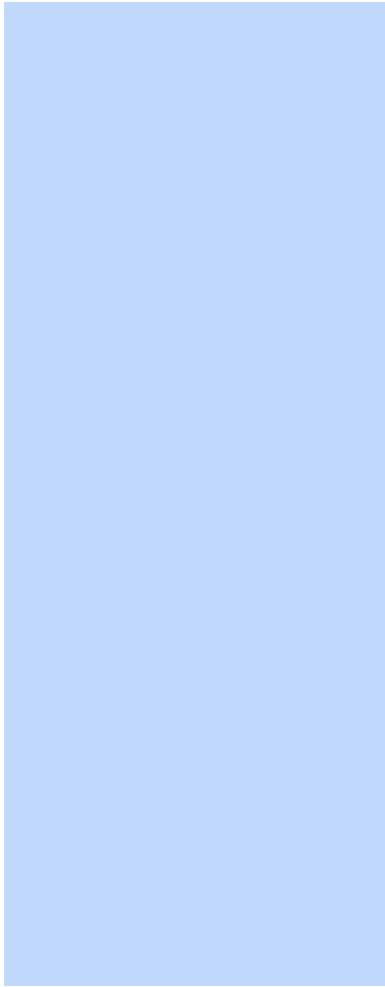
